During her PhD research period she was DAAD Fellow (2015-2016) and Erasmus+ Programme Guest Researcher (2014-2015) at the University of Heidelberg, Germany. Her PhD dissertation focuses on Environmental Liability Directive (ELD) and Polluter Pays Principle (PPP) at EU Environmental Law landscape and her book was published by Sakkoulas publications in 2017.
