After a first career in education, Florentin started international development work in 2001, and has been focusing on transforming regulatory systems since 2004. He has worked in more than 50 countries in all parts of the world, advising national and local governments and many regulatory agencies large and small. His work has focused primarily on regulatory delivery (inspections and enforcement, licensing and permitting), and he has covered a wide range of regulatory fields (food safety, environment, occupational safety, technical regulations and product safety, construction, energy, education, public health etc.). He is one of the leading experts and authors in regulatory delivery. After 15 years with the World Bank Group, he spent 5 years at the OECD, and left to be one of the founders of IRIDE and its first Director.
