

Panagiotis Grigoriou is Professor in International and European Institutions, at the Department of Sociology of the University of Aegean. Since 2002 he holds a Jean Monnet Chair on the European Political Integration. Between 2014 and 2017 he was Dean at the School of Social Studies at the University of the Aegean and Director of the international Summer School on European Governance- GovArt.

Since 2017, he is Director of the Laboratory of Political and Social Institutions of the University of the Aegean (School of Social Sciences). Since 2022, he is Director of the Master's Programmes on European Integration and European Societies and Management of Refugee and Migratory Flows in Europe at the University of the Aegean (in english).

Between 2008 and 2013 he was a member of the Congress of the Euro-Mediterranean University (EMUNI) in Slovenia and has also participated actively in its educational activities. He was President of the Administrative Board of the European Community Studies Association (ECSA – Greece, 2013-2016) and Secretary General of the Hellenic Society for International Law and International Relations (2020-2023).

He has taught as visiting professor in many academic institutions in Europe, in Africa and in Canada (Paris III- Sorbonne Nouvelle, Nantes, Institut d' Etudes Politiques de Strasbourg, Krakow, Faculty of Public Administration & Political Science of Bucharest, Montpellier 3, Institut européen de Genève, Centre européen de formation de Berlin, Laval, Sherbrooke, UQAM, Montréal, Marrakech, Abidjan, etc). Since 2024, he is lecturer at the University of Luxembourg (Chair of Parliamentary Studies).

His scientific work is focused on European law and European politics issues, but also on topics that deal with International Law.
