

Bruno de Oliveira Biazatti is a Doctoral Researcher at the Luxembourg Centre for European Law (LCEL). His research explores peripheral agency and politics of expertise in international law-making, with emphasis on the work of the International Law Commission. He teaches international law and international criminal law at the University of Luxembourg. His work has appeared in leading journals, including the *European Journal of International Law*, the *Leiden Journal of International Law*, and the *Journal of International Dispute Settlement*. He was a research fellow at the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg for International, European and Regulatory Procedural Law (2021-2023) and a rapporteur of the Oxford Reports on International Law – International Criminal Law (2021-2023). He was a legal adviser at the Brazilian Supreme Court (2018) and at the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations, in New York (2017).
