

<u>Dr. Nikolaos (Nikos) Papadopoulos</u> is a researcher, lecturer and practicing lawyer specializing in international and European social law and social rights. He is currently a Resident Lecturer at the European Law and Governance School (ELGS) of the European Public Law Organization (EPLO), where he also serves as Academic Coordinator of the <u>LL.M. in International Organizations</u>.

Dr. Papadopoulos has previously held research and teaching positions at several universities and academic institutions, including Maastricht University, the University of Turin, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and European University Cyprus. He has also served as an expert and consultant for various international, public and private organizations, including the Council of Europe, the European Union and the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs of the Hellenic Republic.

He holds a Ph.D. in Law from Maastricht University, where he <u>defended</u> his dissertation, "<u>Recharting the Judicial Enforcement of the European Social Charter at the National Level</u>", under the supervision of Prof. Bruno de Witte and Prof. Anne Pieter van der Mei. His doctoral research was supported by a State Scholarships Foundation (IKY) scholarship in cooperation with the National Bank of Greece.

Dr. Papadopoulos also holds an LL.M. in European Law (cum laude) from Maastricht University, an LL.B. (magna cum laude) from European University Cyprus, where he studied under an *Academic Excellence* scholarship, and a B.A. in Political Science and Public Administration from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.

He has <u>published</u> over 20 articles and book chapters in international and national peer-reviewed journals and edited volumes, and has <u>presented</u> his research in numerous conferences worldwide. He currently serves as Coordinator of the Greek section of the Academic Network on the European Social Charter and Social Rights (<u>ANESC/RACSE</u>) and is a member of the Social Administration Research Lab (<u>SARL</u>) of the University of West Attica. In addition, he has participated as a coach and jury member in various moot court competitions.

A qualified lawyer with the Athens Bar Association, Dr. Papadopoulos previously worked as an associate at a law firm in Athens, specializing in social law. He is an alumnus of the American College of Greece and is fluent in Greek, English, French and German.
