In particular, he has provided legal advice for multiple European e-infrastructures and research infrastructures, including the setting up of the OpenAIRE Legal Entity, CLARIN, META-SHARE, EOSC, DARIAH, HELIX (Greek Digital Infrastructure for Research) etc. He has over 120 publications and talks on legal and business aspects of open technologies, digital content and IPR and innovation policy and strategy. Prodromos has served as the Chair of the Administrative Council of the Greek Industrial Property Organisation (OBI) and he is chairing the Supervisory Board of the European Patent Academy (EPA)."
